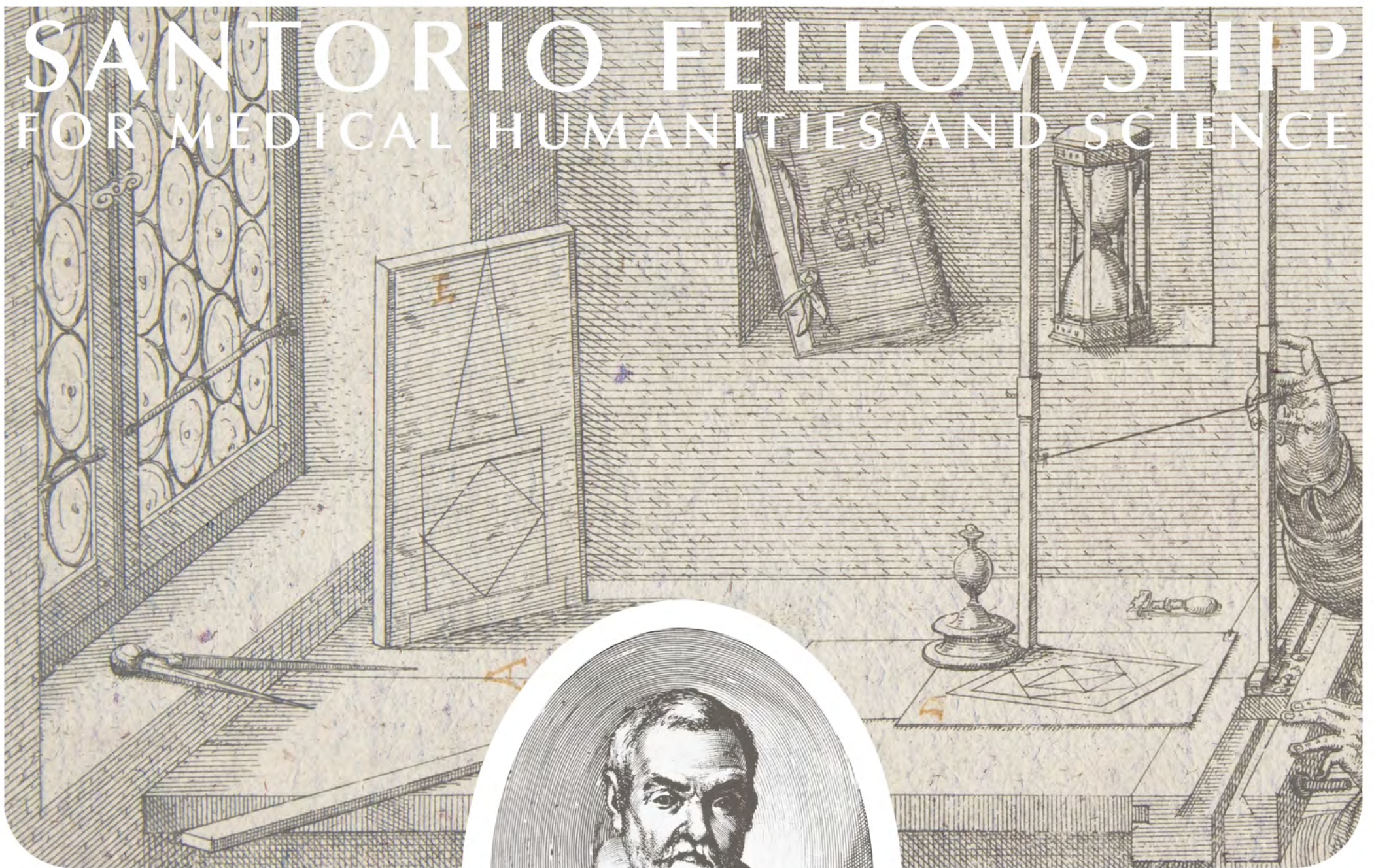

announces an international scheme entitled to the Italian physician **Santorio Santori** (1561-1636) who introduced the quantitative method to medicine and is considered the father of experimental physiology.

AIMS

The Santorio Fellowship for Medical Humanities and Science aims at encouraging cooperation amongst scholars across Europe and worldwide, and is awarded every two years to students (MA and PHD) and early career researchers whose interests in the field of Medical Humanities are particularly strong and well recorded.

For the academic year 2020-2021, the scheme will support participants to the international summer school *Latitudes of the Body. Human-Based Measurement and its Contexts, from Leonardo to Newton (1400-1700)* held in Pisa, 21-24 July 2021.

APPLICATION PROCESS

5 fellowships, worth of € 500 each, will be offered throughout as a gratuity to join the Summer School by means of an application process.
